Navigator. It's one of the most critical roles at Clear Creek Community Church. Navigators have the beautiful and weighty responsibility of guiding people into full devotion to Jesus Christ through a small group environment. Navigators are entrusted with people to steward spiritually—helping them grow in their love for Jesus, his church and his mission of reaching the unchurched for the Kingdom of God.

The Definition of Group

A small group at CCCC is generally a group of 3-12 individuals led by a member of CCCC that is predictable, intentional, sustainable and accountable.

The Values of Group

1. **PREDICTABLE** – *Meeting regularly in a consistent environment for the purpose of growing to be fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ.*
2. **INTENTIONAL** – *Following a planned approach to life change by becoming fully devoted followers of Jesus.*
The 7G Spiritual Formation Process: At CCCC we have designed a specific path for all groups to walk in order to help others become fully devoted followers of Jesus. This path will take people through the 7G's, which are areas a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ should seek to grow. (Glorify, Grace, Group, Growth, Gifts, Good Stewardship, and Go)
3. **SUSTAINABLE** – *Practicing life in a community at a pace that allows for small group relationships, Bible study, corporate worship, serving God in the church and evangelism in the community.*
4. **ACCOUNTABLE** – *Taking reasonable responsibility for each other's spiritual growth and physical well-being*

How CCCC Supports Navigators

To be **ENCOURAGED** you will be given Group Guides (a staff person to support you as you Navigate)

To be **EQUIPPED** you will be given ongoing training (online and periodic training workshops)

To be **INFORMED** you will be given regular communication (a monthly newsletter with up to date information)

To be **RESOURCED** you will be given tools (online documents and group bible studies)

Navigator Expectations & Commitment

THE QUALIFICATIONS OF A NAVIGATOR

1. *CCCC Membership*
2. *Faithfully growing in the spiritual disciplines (e.g., prayer, Scripture)*
3. *Give at least 10% of your income to CCCC*

THE EXPECTATIONS OF A NAVIGATOR

1. *Make disciples (Fully Devoted Followers of Jesus) in my group and continue growing spiritually with my group*
2. *Attend all C4Training events*
3. *Be the key CCCC communicator to the members of my group*
4. *Oversee the membership process for my group*
5. *Meet with my Group Guide one-on-one 3-4 times per year*
6. *Enlist a Navigator-in-Training for my group*
