

GO CATALYST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a GO Op?

A GO Op is a way of serving our neighbors and those in need throughout the community.

How do I plan a GO Op?

There is a GO Op Guide that teaches you how to plan a GO Op from the initial identification stage to completion.

What is a GO Local Partner?

GO Local Partners are ministries and organizations that partner with CCCC in providing missional opportunities in the 4B area. For each GO Local Partner, we have designated a GO Advocate. A Go Advocate is a CCCC volunteer who serves as a liaison between CCCC and our strategic GO Local partners in providing individuals, groups, and campuses with missional opportunities around the 4B area.

How can I and my small group engage with the GO Local Partner?

You may contact the Advocate to learn about ways that your group can help their organization or ministry.

How can I request funds for a GO Op?

If the cost of a GO Op becomes prohibitive, you can request financial assistance by filling out this form.

How can I share stories and pictures from a Go Op?

You can complete this online form and upload pictures too! This form should be submitted after *every* completed Go Op.

How can I stay up-to-date with news about GO opportunities or needs of the Partners?

Every month a GO Newsletter is sent out; you are automatically subscribed to the Newsletter when you became a Catalyst. You can also connect to the GO Facebook page.

What about those 2 meetings a year?

One meeting is in the fall and one in the spring. The Fall meeting is more of a celebration and is also a great way to stay connected to your fellow catalysts. It's helpful to trade information and ideas. The Spring meeting is more of a training and usually has a guest speaker. Both meetings will include important information that will be helpful to you in your role and will keep you connected.

ONGOING SUPPORT

- Your Navigator will be invaluable support as you find GO Ops for your group and lead them out into the community. Don't be afraid to approach them with thoughts, questions, or concerns.
