

## DEAR PARENTS

We want to partner with you to lead your student through their faith journey. We know it can be challenging, and you might not know where to start. Don't worry! Here are some questions about tonight's message that you can ask your student after groups to kick-start the conversation.

## Imposter

“Who am I?” It’s one of the most important question you can ask but it rarely gets answered, every time we feel like we are close to answering the question the game changes. We live in culture that tries to answer that question for us but it leaves us feeling like the “imposter” in the room. Adopting the worlds answer, seems hopeful but our lives become filled with fear and anxiety. In this two-week series we will take a look at how the Gospel provides an eternal answer to our identity crisis, an answer that rest in the person and work of Jesus Christ.

### **Ask:**

1. Do you feel like it is hard to fit in at places (school, online presence, extracurricular activities, people groups)?
2. Do you feel like people change themselves just so they will be liked? Have you ever done that?
  - a. Parent, this might be a good opportunity for you to share with your student a time that you have done this. Be vulnerable and allow them to see they’re not alone in this.
3. Describe a time in your life where you felt like you were living out your faith and it felt right? How can we as a family do a better job of living out our faith?
