FAMILY BIBLE READING PLAN

This is a once-a-week family worship experience geared toward families with Pre-K and Elementary-aged kids.

We hope this family reading plan helps your family come together to study God's Word. The more you do this, the more it becomes a rhythm in your life and in your kids' lives.

B.R.E.A.D.

The BREAD acronym is a tool designed to help you slow down and prayerfully read the Bible. We will use this to guide us each week.



Be Still

We are going to sit and listen. Find a place where everyone is comfortable and without distractions.



Read

Read the Bible passage or story.



Examine

Use the provided questions to help discuss what you read.



Apply/Activity

Ask, *How does this passage apply to me?* Complete the activity to help reinforce what God is saying through his Word.



Devote to Prayer

Use the prayer prompts to guide you and pray together as a family.

Apply/Activity



If you haven't accepted the gift of Jesus as your rescuer, pray for God to open your heart to his truths. If you are a follower of Jesus, thank him for sending Jesus to save you.

Apply/Activity
