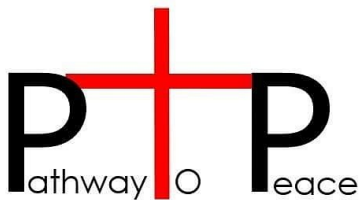
I am getting excited to facilitate small group with Cyndee and looking forward to walking with whomever chooses to join us in seeking the Lord!!
