HELP US KEEP CREEK KIDS A SAFE PLACE:

- Write your child's name on everything.
- Leave all toys at home.
- Have your parent tag ready. You must show it to enter the hallways and to pick up your child.
- Children cannot be released to anyone under 16.
- If we need you during a service, we will text you at the number provided in our database.
- If your child is sick, please stay home with him/her. No fever, vomiting, rash, or diarrhea, in the past 24 hours.
- If we have to evacuate the building, do not come to Creek Kids. Wait for further directions.
- It is our policy to not change cloth diapers for sanitary reasons. If you prefer cloth diapers, please see a Director.

INCIDENTS INVOLVING HARMING OTHERS:

Harming others includes but is not limited to: biting, pinching, kicking, hitting, and pushing.

If a child exhibits a behavior with intent to harm someone else, the child will be removed from the room immediately. Parents will be notified by a director and asked to sign an incident report. Each offense of this nature is numbered.

Here are the consequences of this behavior:

- 1. After 3 offenses within a 6-month time frame, the parents will be asked to stay with the child during the services in Creek Kids.
- 2. Parents must accompany their child in Creek Kids for a minimum of 4 times, or until the Director confirms the child is ready to stay alone.
- 3. After 4 successful instances, the child may stay alone. Any offense resets the process, starting a new six-month period. This may repeat as needed.
